



Certificate in Jewish Education Technology (CJET)

Educators in Jewish after-school/part time settings will develop expertise in integrating technology into their classrooms. This one-year program of online learning and two retreats in New York offers participants the chance to evolve their pedagogic skills as blended and online educators while also strengthening their Jewish content knowledge. Participants will also benefit from mentoring, and will build a network of 21st century educators who will be ambassadors of change at their home institutions.
